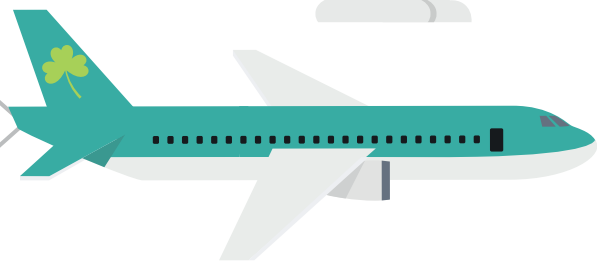


Celebrate St. Patrick's Day

BOSTON



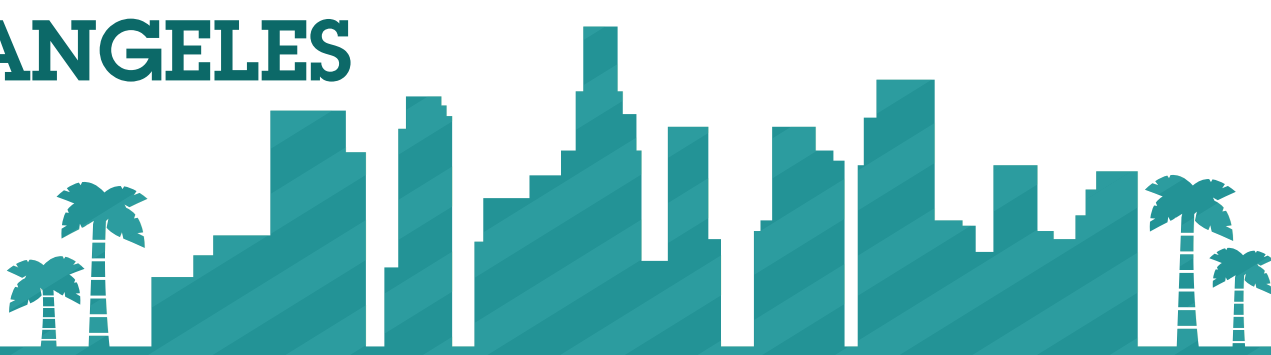
Boston's most famous Celtic punk rock group, the Dropkick Murphys, always return home to Boston for St Patrick's Day at House of Blues, near Fenway Park.
